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Here's the info for our 2010 Ski/Snowboard Program for students in grades 4-6!

- Who:** Students in grades 4th-6th. Parents may choose to purchase additional tickets through the school and drive up so that the whole family can enjoy the reduced rates. However, only 4th-6th grade Fairview students will be allowed to ride the bus and participate in lessons.
- Dates:** January 15th & 29th, 2010 and February 12th & 26th, 2010.
- Deadlines:** Students must have all paperwork and money turned in the Wednesday before we go.
- Times:** We will be leaving the school @ 3:45 and returning between 9:45 and 10 p.m. **(Students cannot stay at school until we leave; they must go home & return @ 3:30 p.m.)**
- Lessons:** Lessons are offered as part of our ski/board program. These lessons are not on a week by week basis. Students who wish to take lessons need to do so for consecutive weeks (the first two trips minimum). Lessons are required of all students who are level 1-2 skiers/ boarders (see sign up form for levels) and must be taken the first two weeks we go. Students who take lessons will be put at the front of our rental line. We meet for lessons in front of the far end of the lodge at the ski school sign at 5:00 p.m. Please note: sometimes we have students whose parents pay for lessons but the student decides to not take the lesson. **It is important to understand that refunds are not available for lessons not taken or those missed because a child becomes ill and cannot go skiing/boarding.**
- Cost:** Tickets and bus are \$17 plus any expense of renting equipment (see sign-up form).
- Food:** We recommend bringing a sack dinner packed with plenty of protein and limited amounts of sugar. Dumping sugar into the body when participating in outdoor sports is dangerous because the end result is a drop of blood sugar and less energy to deal with the cold temperatures! Food is available at the lodge for purchase; however, plan on spending two to three times normal prices for hamburgers and such.
- Clothing:** When participating in a winter sport, the rule of thumb is to wear many layers so that layers can be added or removed as needed.
- Hats:** These are required unless the student is wearing a helmet! Headbands don't keep in body heat!
- Feet:** 2 pr. of socks that come above the calf of the leg, 1 light and 1 medium weight
- Legs:** A pair of long-johns, covered by sweats, then topped with insulated snow pants. A child who tries to ski or board in jeans will end up cold and unhappy.
- Top:** A long-sleeved t-shirt followed by a turtleneck then a sweater or sweatshirt and a warm coat gives versatility and warmth.
- Face:** Something to cover the neck and chin. A turtleneck can do this as can a neck warmer. Scarves aren't allowed because they risk being caught on the lift.
- Hands:** Gloves or mittens specifically made for skiing or snowboarding. These are often nylon or leather and are waterproof. They have extra insulation to keep fingers warm even when wet. Knit mittens or gloves just don't do the trick.

What to turn in:

- Sign-up form (specific to the day(s) you are going)
- Permission Slip (on back of each sign-up form) for each day you will be going
- Kelly Canyon Ski & Board Rental form with all necessary information & signatures (only required once each year; after that it is on file at Kelly's)
- Money (be sure to get a receipt)

Please note, we do offer some need based grants for students. If you are interested in your child participating in this, please contact the principal. Those students wishing to receive a grant need to write a short essay (1/2 to 1 page), signed by a parent/guardian, about what going would mean to them. This essay is due on Friday

- _____ Will be at the school to pick up my child between 9:45 and 10:00 p.m.. Failure to do so will result in my child not being allowed to participate in future ski and board trips.
